Notes for Application

- Please note that your submission will be completed when you have filled out all required fields and make your payment for the application.
- Write down your name exactly same as on your Passport. **You cannot change the major you applied and receive refund for application fee once you have completed your application.**
- All documents must be written in Korean or English. Any documents written in other languages must be translated into Korean or English.
- Please keep your application number once your application completed (It is required for checking interview schedule & results and tuition fee payment)
- **Even if you have finished online registration, you will be excluded from document screening if you don't submit necessary documents within the deadline. → Original or copies via e-mail submission is required.** The documents arrived after the deadline are not acceptable.
- In cases where copies or supplementary documents have been submitted, the original documents must be submitted by **February 20 (Fri), 2026**
- JBNU is not responsible for any disadvantages resulting from writing down invalid contact point or being out of contact.
- JBNU will only accept the official language certificates and Language course completion certificate that were issued within the last two years.



Notes for All Applicants

- All required documents must be original. If originals cannot be submitted, copies can be submitted only if they have been confirmed as true copies of the original by relevant organizations/institutions or the Office of International Affairs at Jeonbuk National University upon submission
 - All the submitted documents and application fee will not be returned or refunded after finishing the application period, and changing the major you applied for is not allowed once the application has been accepted.(The original Certificate of Graduation will be returned after the semester begins)
 - All the information including admission announcements will be posted on the homepage
 - JBNU is not responsible for any disadvantages resulting from not submitting necessary documents, submitting invalid contact points, not following application process, failing to enter the country, not confirming the final application results, being out of contact and etc
 - Evaluation scores and the failure reason for admission is not disclosed.
 - If any of application documents contain false information or forgery, translation errors, proxy test and **other illegal methods, admission is cancelled immediately.** Also, if an applicant is found to be not fully eligible for the requirement, admission may also be rescinded even after the admission has been granted. In this case, application fee and tuition fee are non-refundable. Furthermore, they cannot apply for JBNU for the next 3 years.
 - Applicant who is enrolled in two or more universities on the same semester or fail to pay their tuition fee before the designated deadline is disqualified for Admission.
 - Admitted applicant who is an expected graduate or still attending school/university/college at the time of the application submission must submit a Certificate of Completion or Diploma to the OIA, JBNU by Feb. 20(Fri), 2026, otherwise admission will be canceled.
 - Regulations of JBNU are applied to the items that are not defined on this prospectus and other specifications are decided by the JBNU Admission Committee.
 - Final successful candidates must check through 'Notes for successful applicant', and must apply for their visa, dormitory, insurance, pay their tuition fee and sign up for lectures within the given period.
 - Transfer students are not allowed to change majors while enrolled, but they may pursue double majors or minors
 - As Jeonbuk National University does not recognize dual enrollment, admitted applicants who are currently enrolled at another university must withdraw from their previous institution before enrollment

(Excluding English Track, Namwon Global Campus, and cases where the admitted department and the offered major are the same)
- Changing majors upon advancement to the second year is not permitted. However, beginning in the third year, students may apply for a transfer to another major if desired (limited to one time)

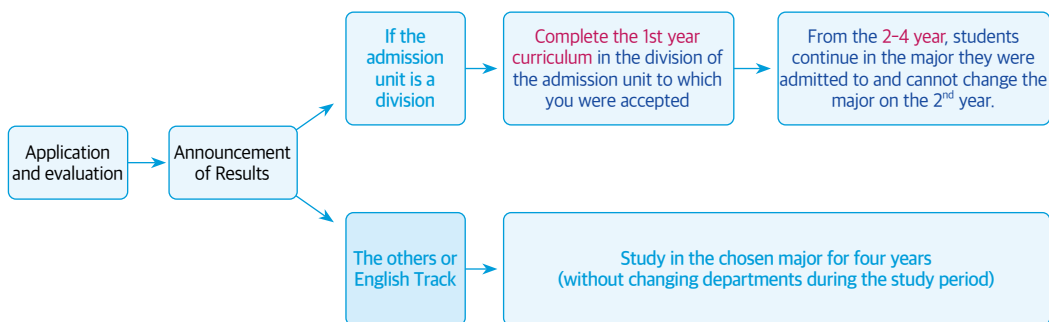

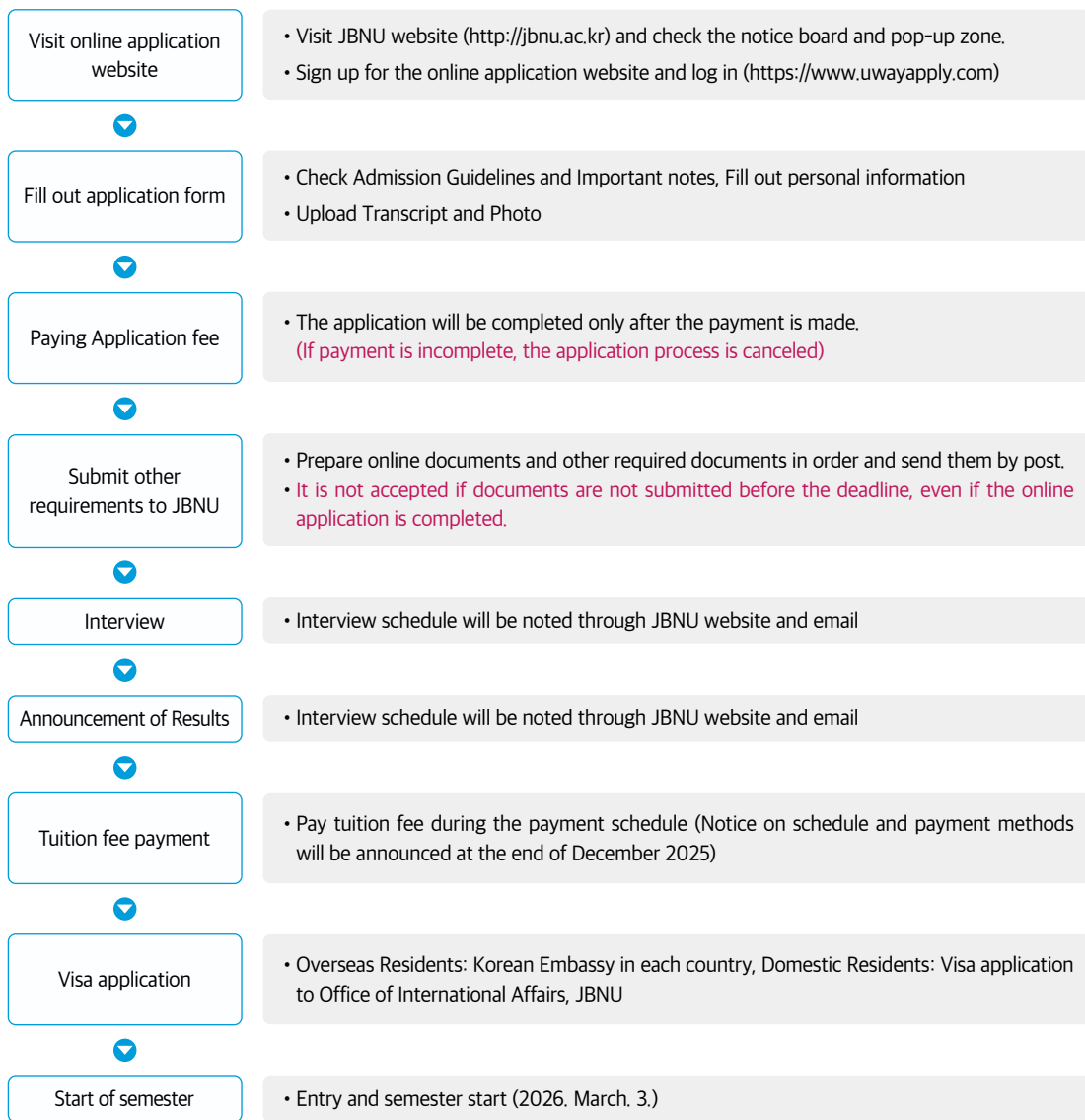

3. National Health Insurance

✔ What APOSTILLE is,

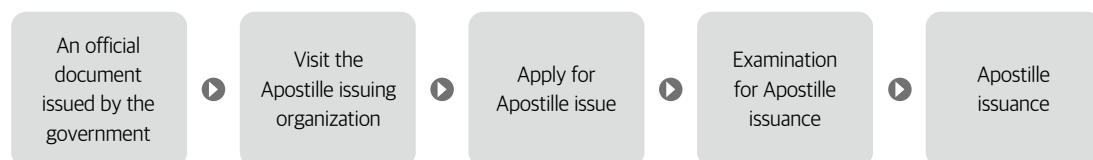
- Since July 14, 2007, the Republic of Korea has been part of the 1961 Hague Convention abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents. The Convention provides for the simplified certification of public (including notarized) documents to be used in countries that have joined the convention.
- An Apostille ensures that public documents issued in one signatory country will be recognized as valid in another signatory country.
